<sup>3</sup> 2013-14 and 2014-15 will be transitional years to new state assessments based on the Kansas College and Career Ready Standards. There will not be fall OTL testing at any grade level. The state will provide more guidance on the new assessment requirements in the fall.

<sup>4</sup> All seniors will be assessed using this portion of the WorkKeys Assessment. This section will only be assessed once and results will not be factored in as part of the graduation requirement that exists with the Reading for Information and Mathematics sections of the WorkKeys Assessment.
